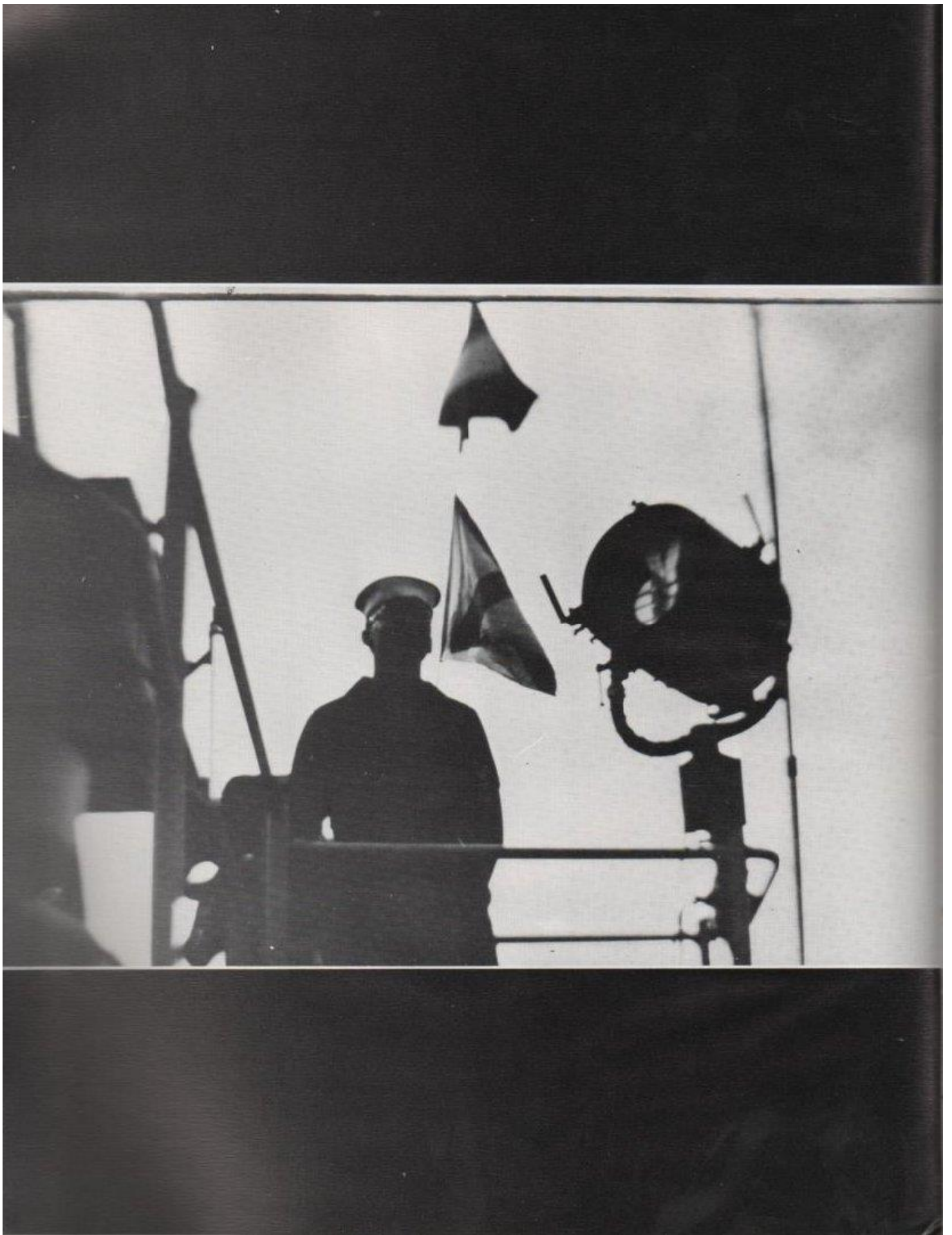

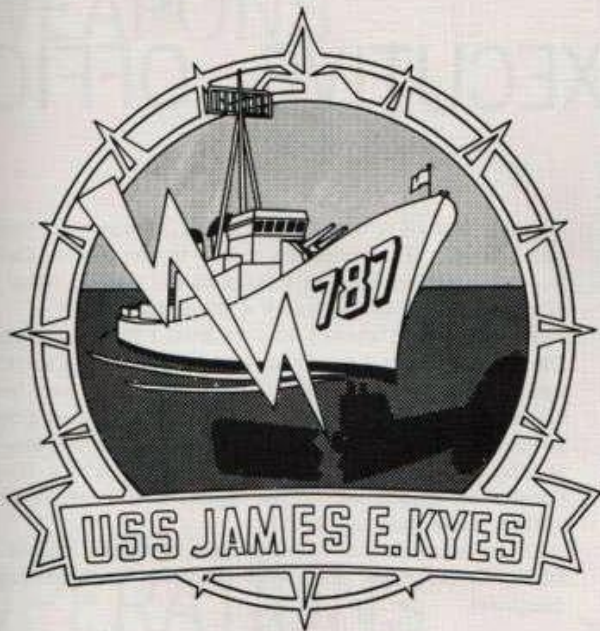

CAPTAIN JOSEPH JAMES DOAK, JR., USN, was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania on January 30, 1923, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Doak, Sr. He attended St. Joseph's College in Philadelphia before entering the United States Naval Academy where he graduated with the class of 1945. CAPTAIN DOAK will be the nineteenth in a line of distinguished naval officers to command the "LITTLE BEAVERS."

CAPTAIN DOAK has served aboard USS QUINCY (CA-71), USS PORTSMOUTH (CL-102), USS HEALY (DD-672), USS LLOYD (APD-63) and USS BORDELON (DDR-881). He has commanded USS VAN VOORHIS (DE-1028), USS D. H. FOX (DD-779), USS BARNEY (DDG-6) and USS SIERRA (AD-18).

His service ashore includes: United States Naval Academy; Tufts University, instructor in the NROTC program; Officer in Charge Naval Ordnance Laboratory Test Facility, Solomons, Maryland; Headquarters of NATO's Supreme Allied Commander Atlantic and Naval Ordnance Systems Command Headquarters, Washington, D.C.

CAPTAIN DOAK is married to the former Miss Elizabeth Jane Holt of Cranford, New Jersey. They have six children: Mary Ellen, 16; Joseph III, 15; Thomas, 11; Peter, 8; Daniel, 6; and Elizabeth, 3.

**ARTHUR J. TALLET** was born in Chicago, Illinois, on 15 December 1929, and is currently a resident of Chicago. He earned his Bachelor's Degree and his commission as Ensign from the Illinois Institute of Technology on 8 June 1951.

He served in the Attack Troop Transport **USS MENIFEE** and Tank Landing Ship 802.
